Our Classes

CLASS 1 – LITTLE EXPLORERS (*Ages 2–4*)

Our youngest learners discover Mandarin through their senses and play. In a carefully prepared **Montessori environment**, they interact with natural materials, learn basic vocabulary through movement and songs, prepare simple dumplings, and care for bamboo plants. Every activity promotes independence, coordination, and a joyful relationship with the Chinese language.

Goals (102 Annual Hours):

- Acquire 60–100 basic Mandarin words
- Understand and follow simple instructions
- Begin socializing in a Mandarin-speaking environment
- Recognize basic directional and action words

Specific Materials:

- Montessori wooden tools for real-life scenarios (e.g. tea ceremony set, dim sum play kit)
- Picture books: *“Little Panda’s Day”*, *“Niu Niu and Friends”*
- Song & movement library: *Head, Shoulders, Knees in Mandarin*, *Two Tigers (两只老虎)*
- Nature-based sensory tools (e.g. bamboo leaves, spice scents)

CLASS 2 – YOUNG ADVENTURERS (Ages 4–6)

Children in this stage are ready for more structured learning. With Montessori materials and visual character boards, they begin character recognition, learn to pronounce tones correctly, and build vocabulary through storytelling and crafts related to Chinese traditions like the Mid-Autumn Festival and Lunar New Year.

Goals (102 Annual Hours):

- Recognize 20–30 basic Chinese characters
- Introduction to Chinese writing strokes
- Build vocabulary of 150–180 words
- Explore 8–10 cultural topics (e.g. Mooncakes, Red Lanterns, Dragon Dance)

Specific Materials:

- Visual Mandarin Stroke Cards
- Character magnets and drawing boards
- Culture kits: Paper lanterns, red envelopes, zodiac animals
- Storybooks: *“The Moon Lady”*, *“The Runaway Rice Cake”*

CLASS 3 – LANGUAGE EXPLORERS (Ages 6–8)

At this level, students begin reading short sentences and writing basic characters. Using structured tools like **Mandarin sentence builders** and guided stories, they develop fluency and critical thinking through discussions. Cultural themes are integrated into texts and group projects.

Goals (102 Annual Hours):

- Read short sentences (10–30 words)
- Write 1–2 sentence stories using known vocabulary
- Dictation of characters and simple phrases
- Vocabulary of 200–250 essential words

Specific Materials:

- Mandarin reading strips (graded by theme)
- “I Can Read in Chinese” series
- Pinyin & stroke order worksheets
- Group story cards and scene-building sets

CLASS 4 – MANDARIN COMMUNICATORS (*Ages 8–12*)

Our most advanced students learn in a mixed-level setting that accommodates both beginners and learners with prior experience. This class emphasizes real-world Mandarin communication, critical thinking, and cultural depth.

For Absolute Beginners (8–12 years old, no prior experience):

- Practice basic introductions and daily phrases
- Read short texts of 80–120 characters
- Write full sentences of 6–10 characters
- Build confidence for verbal expression

For Students with Previous Experience:

- Independently read Chinese books (2–4 pages)
- Write creative texts of 30–80 characters
- Participate in group discussions on cultural and personal topics
- Complete mini research projects on Chinese culture (e.g. “How Lanterns Are Made”)
- Take leadership roles by assisting beginner classmates

Specific Materials:

- *“My First Chinese Reader”* Level 3–4
- Mandarin fluency sentence board and storytelling tiles
- Bilingual cultural project kits (e.g. dragon boat, paper cuttings, tea ceremony)
- Chinese-English word banks and research templates


